## FOREWORD

When I was asked to open the Point Agricultural Show last year, I began reflecting on the way that Point seemed to have become a more cohesive unit in the recent past, and in my address I cited a number of things that supported that view. When I was asked to open the show, there was no indication at the time that writing the foreword for the next year's brochure was part of the deal. However, I could not refuse. On the day of the show last year I said, "Looking ahead, I think we can take heart from things we see around us - evidence that the Rubhaich, whether born here or elsewhere, are invested in contributing to the life of the community."

It is heartening to reflect that even in one year there have been significant events and improvements that show that my optimism was justified. Urras Stòras An Rubha celebrated the official opening of Aros An Rubha, with a visit by HRH The Princess Royal, and the completion of additional facilities, including the laundrette. The Point and Sandwick Trail had their own important community event, with the official opening of the latest path, linking Sheshader and Aird. The Garrabost Mill project is making excellent progress and will soon be completed. In the Point Agricultural Society building we were able to experience the excellent and popular exhibition commemorating 200 years of Portnaguran as a crofting village. The people of Shader are in the process of researching and collecting stories and pictures to commemorate their own 200 year milestone. None of these events would have happened without the dedication of volunteers and the financial input of funders who see the value of our aspirations as a community.

The Point Show itself continues to increase in popularity and is eagerly anticipated. The show would not happen without the generosity of sponsors or without the work of volunteers, who serve in a variety of different ways to ensure the show runs smoothly. As well as the responsibilities on the day of the show, the committee work throughout the year and have additional volunteers to help in the days leading up to the show, and on the following Monday to get everything back in order. I think we are all grateful for a day of rest on the Sunday to recharge batteries before tackling the clearing up.

1. On Show Day all exhibits must be in place by the following times:  
Dog Show (Section 1) by **1:30pm**  
Cattle and Sheep (Sections 2-3) by **11:30am**  
Indoor sections (sections 4-10) by **11:00am**  
Late entries will not be accepted in any section or class.
2. Entry Forms are required for the Horse, Cattle and Sheep sections. Entry Forms can be obtained from Committee members, Section organisers or the Show Website. Entries for these competitions must be lodged with section organisers by **Wednesday 9th July 2025**.  
Note Horse show is on **Tuesday 8th July**, Entries for horse show by **Tuesday 1st July 2025**
3. Section 2 (Cattle) is open to exhibitors who produce stock within the Stornoway Trust Area.  
Sections 1, 3 to 12 are open to any exhibitor.
4. Points (community award) will be awarded in sections 1 to 12 as follows:  
1st prize 3 points....., 2nd prize 2 points....., 3rd prize 1 point  
Rosettes will be awarded to 1st, 2nd & 3rd places in each class except as otherwise stated in Show Brochure.
5. All special trophies will be awarded on the basis of the Judges choice.
6. Should entries in any class not exceed three, the committee reserve the right to limit or reduce the value and/or the number awards.  
All exhibits must be bona-fide the property of the exhibitor. Exhibits must not have been shown at previous Point Agricultural Shows (excluding live-stock).
7. Exhibitors may compete with multiple entries within a section, except sections six and eight where restrictions apply. (Please see relevant sections for details of restrictions) One exhibitor may take more than one prize in any class.
8. No exhibits to be taken away before 5pm.
9. All trophies to be returned in polished condition by eve of the show. Shields may be engraved by the winners but trophies are NOT to be engraved.
10. In all competitions Judge's decision is final.
11. No claim for any damage, loss, injury or accident, to any person, property or their animals arising out of the Point Agricultural Show or conduct of management thereof will be recognised.
12. Businesses or individuals who normally trade for profit or otherwise offer their produce or products for sale cannot exhibit or compete in sections 4 to 11.
13. All Dogs must be kept on a lead and well away from other animal exhibits and spectator areas. Dogs may not be taken into buildings or marquees.



## **Competition Rules and Guidelines**

### **Rules for Stage One - Points Accumulation**

1. All exhibitors from the Point area will be awarded a point for each show section they enter.
2. Points will then be awarded as follows, according to the Judge's decision for each competition class as set out in the Show Brochure:

*1st Prize = 3 points 2nd prize = 2 points 3rd prize = 1 point  
3 points will also be awarded for each Trophy won.*

3. Points will be totalled on a community basis as set out on the 'Eligible Communities' page of this site.
4. The community with the highest total points will receive a prize of £700.
5. The community with the second highest points will be awarded £300.
6. Both these awards will be subject to approval at Stage 2 of the competition.
7. The Stornoway Trust stipulates that prize monies can only be awarded to properly constituted organisations and cannot be awarded to any one individual

### **Rules for Stage Two - Prize Allocation & Award**

1. The exhibitors whose points contributed to the awards must mutually decide how the prize money is to be spent for the benefit of the winning community and or the Point area.
2. If the winning community cannot decide how to allocate their prize by a mutually agreed date, the award will automatically go to the next highest points winner.
3. The final decision on how prize money is spent is subject to approval by the Judging Panel.
4. Only constituted organisations operating within the competition boundary and considered appropriate by the Judging Panel will be eligible to accept and disburse the funds on behalf of the w
5. The decision of the Judging Panel in all aspects of this competition is final.

### **JUDGE PROFILE - FINLAY MACINTYRE**

My family have farmed in Rannoch for many generations. I studied a Bsc Hons in Agriculture from SAC Aberdeen. I started my Auctioneering career with Lawrie and Symington at Forfar mart in 2006 before moving to ANM in 2008. I came to Dunalastair in 2015, the third generation of my family to work on the 16000 acre Estate for the De Sales la Terriere family; a chance I was fortunate to be afforded. Across the Estate there are ~ 3000 hill ewes, mainly south type blackface and some North Country Cheviot alongside 160 spring calving Luing cows. We also manage an neighbouring Estate of a similar size running around 1000 ewes. All progeny is sold fat on rented grazings and surplus female gimmers sold at UA, Dalmally and Stirling. Surplus heifers are sold at Luing Society sales at Dingwall and Stirling.

When judging I look for honest animals that have breeding characteristics over feeding. They need to walk well, have good bone and be of a sound constitution. A good mouth is paramount to success also.

For many, many years I have admired the stockmanship so often found in Lewis and I am delighted and privileged to be asked to Judge what I am sure will be an exemplary show of stock.




